

# What We Believe

#### Scripture

- Scripture is our final authority in all matters.

- Context is important when interpreting scripture.

#### God

- There is only one true God who is eternal and exists as three separate persons: The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- Isaiah 43:10-11, Colossians 2:9, John 10:30, John 1:1-5

### **Holy Spirit**

  - Mark 16:15-18

#### **Salvation & Transformation**

- The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ provides a way for all to be reconciled back to God.
- The finished work of Christ restores to believers everything that was lost as a result of sin.
- Salvation is the beginning of transformation.
- Colossians 1:20-23

#### **Creation**

- The goal of God was not to create a religion, but to establish a family.
